EMISSION CONTROL RESIDENCY AFFIDAVIT

Nevada regulations require a vehicle emission inspection prior to the registration of your vehicle.

If your vehicle is not currently available for a Nevada emission inspection, or you are not currently residing in a county that requires a Nevada emission inspection, you may register your vehicle or renew your current registration by completing the residency affidavit on the reverse side of this form.

If you are currently residing in an area out of state that requires an emission inspection, you must provide an emissions certificate from that state as proof that your Nevada-registered vehicle meets the requirements of that program.

Please return the residency affidavit, your registration renewal form, a valid emission certificate, if required (see above), and a check or money order in the exact amount of your registration fee prior to the expiration of your current registration. Mail to:

AFFIDAVIT

I am requesting, at this time, I be allowed to register my vehicle or renew my vehicle registration without obtaining a Nevada vehicle emission inspection report as required by NRS 445B.795. My vehicle is not required to have or is currently unavailable for a Nevada emission inspection. I understand that to use a false or fictitious name or address in my application for registration of any vehicle on any renewal or duplicate thereof, or knowingly to make a false statement or knowingly to conceal a material fact or otherwise commit fraud in any such application, is unlawful. A violation of this subsection is a gross misdemeanor and may constitute grounds for cancellation of the vehicle registration.

- The county, or area in a county, in the State of Nevada where this vehicle is located does not require motor vehicle emission inspection.
- The state where this vehicle is located does not require motor vehicle emission inspection. I will submit my Nevada vehicle emission inspection report to the Department of Motor Vehicles within 10 days upon returning to the State of Nevada. Failure to submit the vehicle emission inspection report within 10 days upon returning to the State of Nevada may result in the cancellation of registration pursuant to NRS 482.461.
- I am submitting, at this time, an emission inspection report that verifies motor vehicle emission compliance pertaining to the state and county laws where the vehicle is located currently. This report fulfills my motor vehicle emission-testing requirement for the subsequent 12-month registration period.
